

# MIDDLE & SENIOR SCHOOLS UNIFORM

Students are required to wear the correct uniform as described below ensuring that it is clearly named, of correct fit, clean, neat and in a state of good repair.

On especially cold days, extra clothing may be worn underneath the school uniform but it must not be visible.

# **GIRLS' SUMMER UNIFORM**

Dress: Pedare style - striped with dark blue trim on collar and cuffs.

(College length - must be well **below** the knee, when standing).

Middle School dress has an additional dark blue tie.

Socks: White, cotton/nylon ankle socks (which must fully cover the ankle bone).

Shoes: Black leather *(able to be polished),* lace up school shoes with a low heel.

Jumper: Senior and Middle School - Pedare Blue, Silver Fleece, double V-neck, with fully

embroidered Pedare logo.

Blazer: Senior and Middle School - Pedare Blue, Macquarie, poly/twill, unisex style, fully lined

with welted pockets and full embroidered Pedare logo.

The school blazer is our most formal dress item. It is to be kept in the very best condition. (The blazer is optional in Summer; but must be worn on all formal occasions, as advised by the

College).

Hat: Senior and Middle School - 'Natasha' by Mountcastle, white with navy braid under brim

and Pedare logo woven into hatband.

The formal hat is optional, but a College hat must be worn with the College uniform for excursions and formal outdoor occasions, in Terms 1 and 4. Students are encouraged to wear a College hat when travelling to and from the College.

### **GIRLS' WINTER UNIFORM**

Blazer: Senior and Middle School - Pedare Blue, Macquarie, poly/twill, unisex style, fully lined with

welted pockets and fully embroidered Pedare logo. (Must be worn to and from the College in

Terms 2 and 3 and on all formal occasions, as advised by the College).

Shirt: Senior School – White, poly/cotton, self-stripe, long sleeve shirt, with small embroidered

Pedare logo on chest pocket and button up collar.

Middle School - Soft blue, poly/cotton, long sleeve shirt with fully embroidered Pedare logo

on chest pocket and button up collar.

Skirt: Senior and Middle School - Pedare style - striped, with Pedare logo watermark, poly/wool

fabric. (College length. Must be well below the knee when standing).

Tie: Senior School – French Navy, embossed with Pedare logo.

Middle School - Cross over tie to match winter pinafore, with gold button stamped with

Pedare logo.

Jumper: Senior and Middle School - Pedare Blue, Silver Fleece, double V-neck, with fully

embroidered Pedare logo.

Vest: Senior and Middle School. Optional - Pedare Blue, Silver Fleece, double V-neck, with fully

embroidered Pedare logo.

Stockings: Navy, 70 denier opaque stockings/tights.

Socks: Optional. Ink navy, knee high, cotton/nylon. (Must be covered by skirt when standing).

Shoes: Black leather (able to be polished), lace up school shoes with a low heel.

Scarf: Optional. Plain navy or College scarf.

Gloves: Optional. Black or navy.

#### GIRLS AND BOYS' PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM

Shorts: Senior and Middle School - Navy blue, micro fibre shorts embroidered with PEDARE.

Shirt: Senior School – White, short sleeve sports polo shirt embossed with PEDARE. Dark navy

collar striped with College colours. Optional – long sleeved version of the same.

Middle School - Soft blue, short sleeve sports polo shirt, embossed with PEDARE. Dark

navy collar striped with College colours. Optional – long sleeved version of the same.

Socks: White 'Pedare' sports socks, with navy cushion foot and striped bands in College colours

(which must fully cover the ankle bone).

Shoes: Dark or white coloured lace-up, sports shoes with non-marking soles, a suitable arch

support. Please note that 'Skate' shoes, 'Canvas' shoes or 'Street' shoes are not suitable or healthy for playing sport and are not safe for walking around the College and are therefore NOT permitted to be worn at all whilst in College uniform or when travelling to and/or from

the College.

Tracksuit: Senior and Middle School - Navy blue, micro fibre tracksuit, with PEDARE embroidered on

jacket and leg. Jacket with gold and burgundy trim. Rugby jumper.

Hat: Senior and Middle School - Navy, poly/cotton, wide brim, bucket sports hat, embroidered

with PEDARE.

Compulsory for PE lessons. May be worn at recess and lunch time.

#### **BOY'S SUMMER UNIFORM**

Shirt: Senior School – Striped, poly/cotton, short sleeve shirt with small embroidered Pedare logo

on chest pocket and button up collar. Straight cut across bottom.

Middle School – Soft blue, poly/cotton, short sleeve shirt with fully embroidered Pedare logo on chest pocket and button up collar. Straight cut across bottom with side button

adjustment tabs.

Trousers: "Borderex" charcoal mix No. 12, poly/viscose, with side button adjustment and belt loops or

 $\frac{1}{2}$  elastic back with double knee. Small embroidered logo appears on the front just below the

pocket.

Shorts: "Borderex" charcoal mix No. 12, poly/viscose, with side button adjustment and belt loops or

½ elastic back. Small embroidered logo appears on the front just below the pocket.

(Optional for Senior and Middle School).

Socks: Grey to match shorts/trouser fabric. Cotton/nylon "Up 'n Downer".

Shoes: Black leather (able to be polished), lace up school shoes with low heel.

Jumper: Senior and Middle School - Pedare Blue, Silver Fleece, double V-neck, with fully

embroidered Pedare logo.

Tie: **Senior School** – French Navy, embossed with Pedare logo.

Middle School – French Navy with wide stripes and Pedare logo.

(Optional in Summer, but must be worn with the blazer for all formal occasions as advised

by the College).

Blazer: Senior and Middle School - Pedare Blue, Macquarie, poly/twill, unisex style, fully lined with

welted pockets and fully embroidered Pedare logo (optional in Summer; but must be worn

on all formal occasions, together with the tie.

NB. Shorts may be worn with the blazer in Terms 1 and 4.

Hat: Senior and Middle School - 'Aussie Mate' by Mountcastle, Newcastle Blue, poly/rayon with

fully embroidered Pedare logo.

The formal hat is optional, but a College hat must be worn with the College uniform for excursion and for formal outdoor occasions, in Terms 1 and 4. Students are encouraged to

wear a College hat when travelling to and from the College.

# **BOYS' WINTER UNIFORM**

Blazer: **Senior and Middle School** - Pedare Blue, Macquarie, poly/twill, unisex style, fully lined with welted pockets and fully embroidered Pedare logo. The school blazer is our most formal dress

item. It is to be kept in the very best condition. (The blazer is optional in Summer, but must be worn on all formal occasions, as advised by the College).

Shirt: Senior School – Striped, poly/cotton, long sleeve shirt with small embroidered Pedare logo

on chest pocket and button up collar. Straight cut across bottom.

**Middle School** - Soft blue, poly/cotton long sleeve shirt with fully embroidered Pedare logo on chest pocket and button up collar. Straight cut across bottom with side button adjustment tabs.

Jumper: Senior and Middle School - Pedare Blue, Silver Fleece, double V-neck, with fully

embroidered Pedare logo.

Vest: Senior and Middle School. Optional - Pedare Blue, Silver Fleece, double V-neck, with fully

embroidered Pedare logo.

Trousers: "Borderex" charcoal mix No. 12, poly/viscose, with side button adjustment and belt loops or ½

elastic back with double knee. Small embroidered logo appears on the front just below the

pocket.

Tie: **Senior School** – French Navy, embossed with Pedare logo.

Middle School – French Navy with wide stripes and Pedare logo.

Shoes: Black leather (able to be polished), lace up school shoes with a low heel.

Socks: Grey to match shorts/trouser fabric. Cotton/nylon "Up 'n Downer".

#### **GIRLS AND BOYS' BACK PACK**

'Spartan' Lite-Pack. Medium and large sizes. Navy, printed with PEDARE. **Compulsory** for all students.

#### WEARING THE COLLEGE UNIFORM CORRECTLY

It is essential that all students wear the College uniform correctly.

The College management reserves the right to make final decisions regarding uniform and grooming.

Any student who attends the College wearing **incorrect uniform** will be asked to correct it immediately.

Any student who attends the College **incorrectly groomed** will be asked to correct it immediately. If the issue can be easily and immediately corrected, students will be issued with a lunch time detention.

If it cannot, this may mean:

- being sent home to change—obtaining parental phone consent
- correct uniform being brought to the College for changing
- undertaking their studies in "isolation" if correction cannot be made.

Where correction is not immediately possible, students will be given one week to correct and be issued with a Friday detention.

Correct College uniform, as outlined in the Dress Code for each sub school, is to be worn on all occasions when attending the College, when representing the College or when travelling to and from the College at any time outside of College hours.

The College uniform is to be purchased from Devon Clothing located at the Campus Uniform Shop or from the Parents & Friends' Second Hand Uniform Shop.

Summer uniform is to be worn in Terms 1 and 4.

Winter uniform is to be worn in Terms 2 and 3.

During the change of seasons, at the end of one term and the beginning of another, the students may wear either the complete summer or winter uniform, but not a mixture of both.

The PE uniform is to be worn only on timetabled PE lesson days or for sporting competitions and carnivals, as specified by the College. It is not able to be worn on sporting practice days.

In Terms 2 and 3, the full tracksuit is to be worn to and from the College. The rugby jumper can be the outer layer of clothing to and from College and will be the official requirement as of the beginning of 2013.

No other visible garments may be worn with the correct College uniform with the exception of a plain white round-necked t-shirt worn underneath the College shirt.

### Hair

• 'Hair styles and colouring' – For both boys and girls' hair styles, while being contemporary must be deemed as suitable by the Heads of School. Discreet tinting, colouring and dying of hair is permitted

within the *natural colour range* of your hair. Students with unsuitable hairstyles and/or colour will be sent home until the matter is rectified.

- Hair styles are to be neat, tidy and conservative.
- Hair colour that is 'natural in tone' and does not draw attention is permitted.
- Hair is to be kept clear of the eyes and face.
- Hair is not to be cut shorter than a number 3.
- Where hair is longer than collar length it is all to be tied back.
- Boy's faces are to be clean shaven and sideburns are to be no longer than the bottom of the earlobe.
- Ribbons, scrunchies, clips and head bands are to be **navy**, **black or white**. No other hair adornments are permitted.

#### Hats

Hats are to be worn with College uniform, including in the yard during recess and lunch during Terms 1 and 4. Students are encouraged to wear a Pedare Christian College hat when travelling to and from the College.

A College hat must be worn on all excursions and formal outdoor occasions during Terms 1 and 4.

# **Jewellery**

Students may wear one plain, small, gold, silver, pearl or clear stone stud or sleeper in one or both lower ear lobes; and a watch. A sleeper is an earring that can be fully rotated within the ear lobe. Additional visible jewellery and body piercings or markings are not part of the College uniform and will need to be removed immediately. They may be confiscated and collected from student reception at the end of the day.

Students will not be permitted to attend classes until the issue is rectified.

#### Make Up

No make up or coloured nail polish is to be worn. Acrylic nails are not acceptable when they prevent participation in learning activities. Acrylic nails may not have coloured tips.

# **Footwear**

- Middle and Senior School students must wear shoes at all times, not sandals.
- Sport shoes must be lace up or have Velcro fasteners.
- Thongs are not permitted on campus at any time, including casual days and sports carnivals.
- Skate shoes, canvas shoes and Dunlop Volley style shoes are not permitted as they are not suitable for sporting activities.
- A student is not to wear thongs or sports shoes with their formal uniform in the event of an injury.
