

# College Uniform - Primary School

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The College uniform is the outward sign of membership of the College community. All our students have the right to wear this uniform, and to benefit from the good reputation which the College enjoys in the local community. Each of our students also has the corresponding responsibility to wear the uniform correctly and neatly and to behave in such a way that the community's respect for the College is enhanced. Students are expected to be well-groomed at all times, and to show their self-respect and pride in their school by wearing the uniform correctly.

The uniform is to be clean, neatly pressed and worn in its entirety at all times. Shoes are to be polished.

An explanatory note from a parent is required if full school uniform is unable to be worn at any time.

All compulsory uniform items can be purchased through the school uniform shop.

## Formal Uniform for Girls and Boys

All students are to wear formal uniform to school each day except for days assigned to sport, when sports uniform is worn. T-shirts or singlets worn under the uniform are not to be visible.

**Formal uniform shoes:** Plain black leather lace-up school shoes with regular sole and heel height are required. The College will not accept buckles, skate shoes, jogger or dance style shoes. Velcro shoes are only permitted for Prep to Year 2 students.

**College navy hat:** It is compulsory for all students to wear the College navy hat.

**College jumpers:** Only the College jumper is to be worn. If a student is cold in winter he/she may wear an undergarment, which must not be seen. The College jumper must be the outermost garment worn.

**College vests:** Available for boys and girls.

**College bags:** College bags are compulsory for all students and come in two sizes, to suit all ages.

## For Girls

**Skirts:** Formal uniform dress length is to be on or below the knee.

**Ankle Socks:** Only King's socks are to be worn.

**Tights:** May be worn by all girls in winter – Terms 2 and 3. Navy only.

## For Boys

**Shirts:** Light blue shirt is to be tucked in at all times. Worn with the top button only undone.

**Shorts:** Grey college shorts, worn on the waist.

**Socks:** Long grey King's socks, to be pulled up at all times.

## Sports Uniform

Students may wear sport uniform on their designated PE day and, for Years 4-6, on APS sport days.

**Sports shoes** - These are to be a sports runner or a cross trainer shoe. The shoes should be lace up, non-marking sole with arch support. Basketball boots, canvas style shoes, walks shoes and skateboard shoes are not acceptable sports footwear.

**Sports socks** - Kings' short white socks for boys and girls or longer style socks for boys with college logo. No other socks with logos are allowed. No plain white allowed either.

**Sports shorts & shirts** - These are to be worn by all boys and girls. Shorts are to be worn on the waist and should be mid-thigh in length.

**House shirt** - The house shirt is worn at King's sporting carnivals. It is not worn for school sport or PE days. Students are encouraged to wear their house shirt in support of their house.

**Tracksuits** - To be worn over sports uniform only. Sports shorts must be worn under tracksuit bottoms. Tracksuit pants must be worn with the tracksuit top not the college jumper. The pants are not to be worn alone. The tracksuit top is not to be worn with the formal uniform.

**Swimmers** - For girls, a one-piece navy or black swimsuit. For boys, navy or black speedo style, longer leg swimmers or school skins. All students must wear school swimmers for interschool competitions. A non-school rash vest may be worn except for school representative teams.

# College Uniform - Primary School

## General Appearance

Here are some guidelines that may assist you in ensuring standards of general appearance are maintained:

**Girls' Hair & accessories** - Hair that is longer than the nape of the neck must be tied back in a ponytail or similar. Hair styles are to be kept simple. No multiple braiding or the like. Hair is not to be left loose. Hair is to be clear of the eyes. Hair colouring must be natural looking. Two-tone colouring is not acceptable. Students will be excluded from school until hair colour is acceptable. The only hair accessories allowed are the official college scrunchies, navy or white ribbons, navy clips and navy headbands. Decorative hair bands, ornamental bows, flowers, hair wraps etc. are not allowed. A final decision on hair will always be at the discretion of senior staff.

**Boys' hair** - Hair must be tidy, short and clear of the collar, ears and eyebrows. All haircuts must be of conservative style and no shorter than a No. 3 (Grade 3). The spirit of the code is that haircuts should not follow temporary fads or be attention-seeking. A very small amount of hair product may be used if it helps the student to comply with the code. Hair colour should be natural looking. Students will be excluded from school until hair is acceptable. A final decision on hair will always be at the discretion of Senior Staff.

**Make-up** - No make-up is to be worn by students at school. This includes foundation, tinted moisturiser, blush, mascara or coloured eye make-up.

**Nails** - Coloured or tinted nail polish is not to be worn and any type of false fingernail is not acceptable. If students are found with make-up, they will be asked to remove it immediately.

**Jewellery** - No jewellery is to be worn by male or female students with the exception of a watch (please refer to the Electronic Device note in the General Information).

**Earrings** - Girls may wear one pair only – plain gold or silver studs or sleepers – in the middle of the ear lobe. No coloured or clear stones or fancy designs are acceptable. No male student is permitted to wear earrings.

All students are expected to comply with the school uniform code at all times.



# College Uniform -

## *Wear your uniform with pride!*

The College uniform is the outward sign of membership of the College community. All our students have the right to wear this uniform, and to benefit from the good reputation which the College enjoys in the local community. Each of our students also has the corresponding responsibility to wear the uniform correctly and neatly and to behave in such a way that the community's respect for the College is enhanced. Students are expected to be well-groomed at all times, and to show their self-respect and pride in their school by wearing the uniform correctly.

- \* The uniform is to be clean, neatly pressed and worn in its entirety at all times. Shoes are to be polished.
- \* An explanatory note from a parent is required if full school uniform is unable to be worn at any time.
- \* HOWEVER, it will be at the discretion of Senior staff if a student is to be placed Out of Circulation (OOC) in the Library to work for the day, regardless of having a note.

## Dress Uniform

All students are to wear dress uniform to school each day except Sport days when sports uniform is worn. T-shirts are not to be worn under shirts. Students are not to colour in/or deface the College crest on any uniform.

### Girls and Boys

- **Formal Uniform shoes:** Plain black leather lace-up school shoes with regular sole and heel height are required. The College will not accept buckles, velcro, skate shoes, jogger or dance style shoes.
- **College navy hat:** It is compulsory for Years 7 – 12 to wear the hat during lunchtimes. It is recommended that the College hat and sunscreen are worn at sporting events. The hat is not to be worn during class.
- **College jumpers:** Only the College jumper is to be worn. If a student is cold in winter he/she may wear an undergarment, which must not be seen. The College jumper must be the outermost garment worn. **Not the College Tracksuit top!**
- **College vests:** Available for boys and girls.
- **College blazer:** This is compulsory for Years 10, 11 and 12, and optional for Years 7, 8, 9. The blazer is to be worn during winter and at formal school functions, e.g. Presentation Night, Debating and at any time when representing the school. Male students are to wear the blazer with long College grey trousers, not with shorts.
- **College bags:** These are compulsory. On sports days an additional bag may be used.

### Girls

- **Skirts:** Dress Uniform skirt length is to be **below the knee**. The waistband is to be worn on the waist.
- **Ankle Socks:** King's socks (compulsory) are available from the Uniform Shop.
- **Tights:** For senior students on formal occasions. May be worn by all girls in winter – Terms 2 and 3. These navy tights are to be purchased from the Uniform Shop. Black stockings and tights are not to be worn.

### Boys

- **Ties:** These are to be worn from the first Monday in May for Terms 2 and 3.
- **Shirts:** In Term 1 and Term 4 the formal shirt is to be worn with the top button only undone.
- **Shorts:** These must be worn with a standard, plain black belt with a silver buckle, available at the Uniform Shop.
- **Socks:** To be pulled up at all times.
- **Trousers:** To be worn with black belt. Only grey socks should be worn with trousers.

# General Appearance

## Girls and Boys

- **Jewellery:** No jewellery is to be worn by male or female students with the exception of a watch with a plain band.
- **Earrings:** No male student is permitted to wear earrings. Girls may wear one pair only – plain gold or silver studs or sleepers – in the middle of the ear lobe. No coloured or clear stones, pearls or fancy designs are acceptable.
- **Body & tongue piercing:** These are not acceptable. Clear plastic studs are not allowed.
- **Tattoos:** These are not acceptable. Tattoos must not be visible at any time. Failure to comply with this condition will result in the termination of enrolment.

## Girls

- **Girls' hair and hair accessories:** Hair that is longer than the nape of the neck must be tied back in a ponytail or similar. Hairstyles are to be kept simple. No multiple braiding or the like. No hair is to be left loose. Hair is to be clear of the eyes. Hair colouring must be natural looking. Two-tone hair colouring is not acceptable. Students will be excluded from school until hair colour is acceptable. The only hair accessories allowed are the official College scrunchies, navy or white ribbons and navy headbands. The College Uniform Shop also sells regulation hair accessories. Alice bands and ornamental bows, flowers, hair wraps, etc. are not allowed. A final decision on hair will always be at the discretion of Senior Staff.
- **Make-up:** No foundation, tinted moisturiser, blush or coloured eye makeup is to be worn. Special consideration will be given for medicated foundation in cases where medical documentation from a dermatologist has been received by the College. Eyelash extensions, false eyelashes and eyebrow tattoos are not acceptable.
- **Nails:** No artificial nails. No coloured nail polish to be worn. No fingernail decoration.

## Boys

- **Boys' hair:** Hair must be tidy, short and clear of the collar, ears and eyebrows. All haircuts must be of conservative style and no shorter than a No. 3 (Grade 3). The spirit of the code is that haircuts should not follow temporary fads or be attention-seeking. A very small amount of hair product may be used if it helps the student to comply with the code. Hair colour should be natural looking. Students will be excluded from school until hair is acceptable. A final decision on hair will always be at the discretion of Senior Staff.
- Boys must be clean shaven.

## Sports Uniform

Students with PE lessons are expected to arrive at the College in dress uniform and change into sport uniform for the lesson only. Students are not to colour in/or deface the College crest on any uniform item.

- **Sports shoes:** These are to be a sports runner or a cross trainer shoe. The shoes should be lace up, non-marking sole with arch support. **Basketball boots, canvas style shoes, walk shoes and skateboard shoes are not acceptable sports footwear.**
- **Sports socks:** King's short white socks for boys and girls or the longer style for boys with College logo.
- The College logo must be visible at all times. No other socks with logos are allowed. Plain white socks are not allowed.
- **Sports shorts:** These are to be worn by all boys and girls. These are to be purchased from the College.
- **Sports shirts:** As above.
- **Sports Cap:** This is only to be worn with the Sports Uniform.
- **House shirt:** COMPULSORY. This must be worn on all Interhouse Carnival Days. It can be worn for PE lessons Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, however, it must NOT be worn on Wednesday or Friday. On days that involve fusion, sport training and APS rounds the striped sport shirt must be worn.

- **Tracksuits:** To be worn over sports uniform only. Sports shorts must be worn under tracksuit bottoms. Tracksuit pants must be worn with the tracksuit top, not the College jumper. The pants are not to be worn alone. Tracksuit only worn in Terms 2 and 3. **The Tracksuit top is NOT to be worn with the formal uniform.**
- **Swimmers:**
  - Girls** - One piece only to be worn at any school event.
  - Boys** - Speedo style or those with the longer legs. Swimmers are available from the Uniform Shop. All must wear school swimmers for inter-school competitions.

## Camp Dress Code

On camp, students are required to wear clothing that will enable them to move freely and participate in school activities. We therefore require students to wear appropriately modest clothes, in keeping with our Christian ethic at all times.

### Girls - The following is acceptable:

- T-Shirts or tops with sleeves
- Mid-length dresses with sleeves
- Mid-length shorts (school sport shorts length)
- Mid-length skirts
- Jeans (no ripped jeans) or long pants
- Leggings as long as they are worn with appropriate mid-length shorts.
- Covered shoes
- Low heel sandals
- Sports shoes - for outdoor activities
- Hair tied back for activities
- One piece swimsuit with board shorts (no particular length requirement). A rash vest and board shorts need to be worn if a student does not have a one piece swimsuit.

### Girls MUST NOT wear:

- Dresses or tops with thin straps or low necklines
- Short shorts or mini skirts
- For swimwear: no two piece/bikinis.
- Make-up and excessive jewellery

### Boys - The following is acceptable:

- T-Shirts with sleeves
- Shorts
- Jeans (no ripped jeans) or long pants
- Covered shoes
- Sports shoes - for outdoor activities
- Board shorts for water activities

### Boys MUST NOT wear:

- Jewellery

### The following is not acceptable for BOYS or GIRLS:

- Clothing with inappropriate slogans or pictures
- Singlets
- Outfits which expose the midriff
- See-through or tight-fitting clothing - including leggings/tights worn by themselves.
- Thongs

**Failure to comply with these rules will result in the student being sent home.**
