### Primary Uniform

#### Wear your uniform with pride.

The College uniform is the outward sign of membership of the family. All our students have the right to wear this uniform, and to benefit from the good reputation which the College enjoys in the local community. Each of our students also has the corresponding responsibility to wear the uniform correctly and neatly and to behave in such a way that the community's respect for the College is enhanced.

Students are expected to be well groomed at all times, and to show their self-respect and pride in their school by wearing the uniform correctly.

\* The uniform is to be clean, neatly pressed and worn in its entirety at all times. Shoes are to be polished.

\* An explanatory note from a parent is required if full school uniform is unable to be worn at any time.

#### Dress Uniform

All students are to wear dress uniform to school each day except sports day when sport uniform is worn. T-shirts under shirts are not to be worn.

#### Girls

Girl's hair and hair accessories: Hair that is longer than the nape of the neck must be tied back in a pony-tail or similar. Hair styles are to be kept simple. No multiple braiding or the like. No hair is to be left loose. Hair is to be clear of the eyes. The only hair accessories allowed are the official College scrunchies, navy or white ribbons and navy headbands. The College Uniform Shop also sells headbands. Alice bands and ornamental bows, flowers, hair wraps etc. are not allowed. A

**Make-up:** No foundation, blush or coloured eye makeup is to be worn. Special consideration will be given for medicated foundation in cases where medical documentation has been received by the College.

**Dress:** College Dress Uniform. skirt length is to be below the knee.

**Ankle Socks:** Kings style (compulsory) are available from the Uniform Shop.

**Tights:** Navy

May be worn by all girls in winter – Terms 2 and 3.

#### Boys

**Boys' hair:** Hair must be tidy, short and clear of the collar, ears and eye brows. All haircuts must be of conservative style. The spirit of the code is that haircuts should not follow temporary fads or be attention-seeking. A very small amount of hair product may be used if it helps the student to comply with the code. Hair colour should be natural looking. Students will be excluded from school until hair is acceptable. A final decision on hair will always be at the discretion of Senior Staff.

**Shirts:** College primary teal shirt

**Shorts:** College grey primary formal short

**Socks:** To be pulled up at all times.

#### Boys and Girls

**Formal Uniform shoes:** Plain black leather lace-up school shoes with regular sole and heel height are required. No buckles, No jogger style shoes. Only Preps are permitted to wear Velcro fastening shoes. No Mary Jane style for girls.

**College Primary hat:** Hat to be worn by Girls and Boys. No hat – No play. No external writing/names to be visible.

**College jumpers:** Only the College jumper is to be worn. If a student is cold in winter he/she may wear an undergarment, which must not be seen. The College jumper must be the outermost garment worn.

**College bags:** Compulsory.

**Jewellery:** No jewellery is to be worn by male or female students with the exception of a watch with a plain band.

**Earrings:** No male student is permitted to wear earrings. Girls may wear one pair only – plain gold or silver studs or sleepers – in the middle of the ear lobe. No coloured or clear stones or fancy designs are acceptable.

#### Sports Uniform

**Sports shoes:** These are to be a sports runner or a cross trainer shoe. The shoes should be lace up, non-marking sole with arch support. Prep students ONLY are allowed to wear Velcro style sport shoe. Basketball boots, canvas style shoes, walk shoes and skateboard shoes are not acceptable sports footwear.

**Sports socks:** Kings short white ankle sock for boys and girls. No plain white allowed.

**Sports shorts:** These are to be worn by all boys and girls. These are to be purchased from the College

**Sports shirts:** As above.

**House shirt:** Coloured house shirts are to be worn at house carnivals, or at a special sporting event where they will be notified to do so. Students may also change into house shirts at School sport training.

**Tracksuits:** To be worn over sports uniform only. Sports shorts must be worn under tracksuit bottoms. Tracksuit pants must be worn with the tracksuit top not the College jumper. The pants are not to be worn alone. Tracksuit only worn in Terms 2 and 3. Tracksuit top is not to be worn with the formal uniform.

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**Swimmers:**

**Girls/Boys – P-2** are to wear plain swimwear coloured Black, Navy or Teal.

**Boys – 3-6 – School Speedos** or Skin's

**Girls – School one piece,** Skin's optional to wear over one piece.

Non school rash shirts may be worn for both boys and girls, except for school representative team. House swim caps must be worn.

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Students are expected to be well groomed at all times, and to show their self-respect and pride in their school by wearing the uniform correctly.

\* The uniform is to be clean, neatly pressed and worn in its entirety at all times. Shoes are to be polished.

\* An explanatory note from a parent is required if full school uniform is unable to be worn at any time.

\*HOWEVER, it will be at the discretion of Senior staff if a student is to be placed (OOC) Out of Circulation in the Library to work for the day regardless of having a note.

### Dress Uniform

All students are to wear dress uniform to school each day except Wednesday & Friday when sports uniform is worn. T-shirts under shirts are not to be worn.

### Girls

Girl's hair and hair accessories: Hair that is longer than the nape of the neck must be tied back in a pony-tail or similar. Hair styles are to be kept simple. No multiple braiding or the like. No hair is to be left loose. Hair is to be clear of the eyes. Hair colouring must be natural looking. Two-tone hair colouring is not acceptable. Students will be excluded from school until hair colour is acceptable. The only hair accessories allowed are the official College scrunchies, navy or white ribbons and navy headbands. The College Uniform Shop also sells headbands. Alice bands and ornamental bows, flowers, hair wraps etc. are not allowed. A final decision on hair will always be at the discretion of Senior Staff.

**Make-up:** No foundation, blush or coloured eye makeup is to be worn. Special consideration will be given for medicated foundation in cases where medical documentation has been received by the College.

**Nails:** No artificial nails. No coloured nail polish to be worn. No fingernail decoration.

**Skirts:** Dress Uniform skirt length is to be below the knee. The waist band is to be worn on the waist.

**Ankle Socks:** Kings style (compulsory) are available from the Uniform Shop.

**Tights:** Senior students are to wear on formal occasions. May be worn by all girls in winter – Terms 2 and 3.

### Boys

**Boys' hair:** Hair must be tidy, short and clear of the collar, ears and eye brows. All haircuts must be of conservative style. The spirit of the code is that haircuts should not follow temporary fads or be attention-seeking. A very small amount of hair product may be used if it helps the student to comply with the code. Hair colour should be natural looking. Students will be excluded from school until hair is acceptable. A final decision on hair will always be at the discretion of Senior Staff. Boys must be clean shaven.

**Ties:** These are to be worn from the first Monday in May for Terms 2 and 3.

**Shirts:** In Term 1 and Term 4 the formal shirt is to be worn with only the top button undone.

**Shorts:** These must be worn with a standard, plain black belt with a silver buckle, available at the Uniform Shop.

**Socks:** To be pulled up at all times.

**Trousers:** To be worn with black belt. Only grey socks should be worn with trousers.

### Boys and Girls

**Formal Uniform shoes:** Plain black leather lace-up school shoes with regular sole and heel height are required. No buckles, No velcro, No skate shoes, No jogger or dance style shoes.

**College navy hat:** Compulsory Years 7 – 12 are to wear the hat in the breaks. A hat must be worn for sport.

**College jumpers:** Only the College jumper is to be worn. If a student is cold in winter he/she may wear an undergarment, which must not be seen. The College jumper must be the outermost garment worn.

**College vests:** Available for boys and girls.

**College blazer:** This is compulsory for Years 10, 11 and 12. The blazer is to be worn during winter and at formal school functions, e.g. Presentation Night, Debating and at any time when representing the school. Male students are to wear the blazer with long College grey trousers, not with shorts.

**College bags:** Compulsory.

**Jewellery:** No jewellery is to be worn by male or female students with the exception of a watch with a plain band.

**Earrings:** No male student is permitted to wear earrings. Girls may wear one pair only – plain gold or silver studs or sleepers – in the middle of the ear lobe. No coloured or clear stones or fancy designs are acceptable.

**Tattoos and Body Piercing:** These are not acceptable.

### Sports Uniform

Students with PE lessons are expected to arrive at the College in dress uniform and change into sport uniform for the lesson only.

**Sports shoes:** These are to be a sports runner or a cross trainer shoe. The shoes should be lace up, non-marking sole with arch support. Basketball boots, canvas style shoes, walk shoes and skateboard shoes are not acceptable sports footwear.

**Sports socks:** Kings short white for boys and girls or longer style for boys with College logo (available at Uniform Shop). No other socks with logos are allowed. No plain white allowed either.

**Sports shorts:** These are to be worn by all boys and girls. These are to be purchased from the College

**Sports shirts:** As above.

**House shirt:** COMPULSORY. Must be worn on Interhouse Carnival Days. Can be worn for PE lessons Monday, Tuesday and Thursday. NOT to be worn Wednesday or Friday.

**Tracksuits:** To be worn over sports uniform only. Sports shorts must be worn under tracksuit bottoms. Tracksuit pants must be worn with the tracksuit top not the College jumper. The pants are not to be worn alone. Tracksuit only worn in Terms 2 and 3. Tracksuit top is not to be worn with the formal uniform.

### Swimmers:

**Girls** - One piece only to be worn at any school event.

**Boys** - Speedo style or those with the longer legs. Swimmers are available from the Uniform Shop. All must wear school swimmers for interschool competitions.

### Camp Dress Code

On camp, students are required to wear clothing that will enable them to move freely and participate in school activities. We therefore require students to wear appropriately modest clothes, in keeping with our Christian ethic.

### The following is acceptable:

- \* T-Shirts or tops with sleeves
- \* Dresses with sleeves
- \* Mid-length shorts
- \* Mid-length skirts
- \* Jeans or long pants
- \* Covered shoes – for practical classes
- \* Low heel sandals
- \* Sports shoes
- \* Hair tied back for practical classes
- \* One piece swimmers – no 2 piece/bikinis

### Students MUST NOT wear:

- \* Clothing with inappropriate slogans or pictures
- \* Singlets
- \* Dresses or tops with thin straps or low necklines
- \* Short shorts or mini skirts
- \* See-through or tight-fitting clothing
- \* Outfits which expose the mid-riff
- \* Thongs
- \* Make-up and excessive jewellery

Failure to comply will result in the student being required to wear clothing provided by the college, or the student being sent home.
